All tournaments will have a CIRCUIT WEIGHTING OF "1" (one) PLUS FINAL LEAGUE STANDINGS will be included at a weight of "2" (Two) in determining overall CIRCUIT CHAMPIONS.</p> <p>"TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS". . .
