Thus most tournaments have events from beginner level to expert for all ages and for men & women. All results in all events count towards Manitoba & Canadian rankings. Players are also scouted for Provincial Squads Training Program. Results also count towards selection of Manitoba's Provincial Teams for major tournaments like the Canadian Championships and Canada Winter Games.</p> <p>"TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS" . . .
