GET OUT OF THE BASEMENT!

What is it?

It's an individual table tennis league where players play for themselves and move up and down between divisions based upon weekly results. Season-long standings will be based upon % win/loss records with minimum participation standards.

Who is it for?

The league is suitable for players aged 10-12 and up who have some competitive experience. Initial REGISTRATION WILL BE CAPPED AT 50 PLAYERS and a list of RESERVES will be kept.

When & Where is it?

Every Friday night from November 4th, 2022 - May/June 2023 at Daniel McIntyre Collegiate, Lower Gym, 720 Alverstone. Doors open 6:30 pm, ARRIVAL DEADLINE IS 6:50 PM SHARP, Play Starts at 7:10 pm and the last round starts at 8:50 pm. M.T.T.A. must be clear of gym by 9:30 pm.

How does it work?

The 50 players will be placed into 9-10 Divisions of 4-5 players each. Initial placement will be by ratings: first 4/5 = A Div., next 4/5 = B Div., etc. Each night, you play the other 3/4 players in your division. Each week, according to group results, the bottom 1/2 players in a Division move down to the next division and the top 1/2 players move up. The object is to try and achieve as high a division as possible and to maintain your % win/loss record and attendance record. Stats are produced weekly and are posted on the MTTA WEBSITE at www.mtta.ca

Date

The rules?

ITTF rules and regulations in effect. Matches are best 3 out of 5 games to 11 points. Order of play is as per the official League Match Slip. All players are expected to umpire. Only 2 minute warm up allowed before your first match. Defaulted matches count towards your % win/loss record. Results count towards Manitoba & Canadian Ratings & Rankings and a "2x" weighting for MB CIRCUIT STANDINGS. Players must provide their own paddles.

How much does it cost & how do I sign up?

Please see the bottom of this document for seasonal pricing. REGISTRATION is initially RESTRICTED TO THE FIRST 50 PLAYERS WHO SUBMIT THE REGISTRATION FORM COMPLETE WITH FEE PAYMENT! Players after this will be added to the "RESERVE LIST" and have priority as "DROP-INS" (fee will be refunded).

Drop-In Play

Recognizing that on any given night some players may be absent, "RESERVE LIST" players may choose to show up and try to play as a "Drop-In". "Drop-In" fee is \$5.00 and only payable if you are needed to play, i.e. "Drop-Ins" only play if players are absent. "Drop-Ins" selected in order of nightly arrival. Drop-In matches count towards statistics & ratings.
