SR. & JR. PROVINCIAL SQUADS TRAINING PROGRAM:

This program prepares Manitoba’s top Senior & Junior athletes for the Canadian Championships & 2027 Canada Winter Games. It is for serious, dedicated athletes only! Mandatory practices held Monday (Elite), Tuesdays (Team), Wednesdays (Elite) & Thursdays (Team) & Saturdays (Team/ Physical). Also League play Friday nights. **PARTICIPATION IS BY INVITATION ONLY!**

Fee is \$200 for Team practices October to December, and \$240/month for Elite Practices. Players interested in being scouted should register for M.T.T.A.tournaments or the Winnipeg & District League or phone Head Coach Arvin Tronco at 204-925-5943 or Carlos Cuadra at 204-925-5690.

Results also count towards selection of Manitoba’s Provincial Teams for major tournaments like the Canadian Championships and Canada Winter Games.

ALSO THIS YEAR!...“All tournaments will have a CIRCUIT WEIGHTING OF “1” (one) PLUS FINAL LEAGUE STANDINGS will be included at a weight of “2” (two) in determining overall CIRCUIT CHAMPIONS. “TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS”...

The top 16 finishing players in the “Open”, >40 and Junior Male & Female Singles events at our first 4 Circuit Tournaments will receive an invitation into this prestigious elite level event.
